All events above will start no earlier than the scheduled time, however if the previous event runs long, the next event will begin 15 min. after the conclusion of the previous event.

All exhibitors are responsible for attending meetings throughout the entire Livestock Show. Meetings will be announced weigh-in. The Gerald D. Young Agricultural Sciences Center closes each night at 8:00 PM. No one is allowed in any building after 8:00 PM each day of the Livestock Show, unless accompanied by a Katy ISD representative.

SHOW REQUIREMENTS

- Complete (10) community service hours approved by the AST prior to the Livestock Show. (FEB 1ST)
- Participate in 2 Above the Chapter Level Activities (LDE Team, Camps, Ag Olympics, CRHS Feeding Seminar, etc.)
- Participate in Chapter Fundraising activities: sell a minimum of \$500 between the two chapter fundraisers
- Sell a minimum of \$100 in Katy ISD FFA Ad Book Sales

SHOW REQUIREMENTS

- First year exhibitors must recite the FFA Creed during their first semester of Ag enrollment
- Exhibitors who receive two(2) or more Level III disciplinary infractions or any Level IV or V disciplinary infractions will NOT be eligible to show or participate in the Barn Sale or Auction

SHOW REQUIREMENTS

- No Pass/No Play (must pass 3rd six weeks/Pass ALL classes on 4th six weeks progress report)
- Neatly groomed, no jewelry
- Exhibitors must complete the online Quality Counts program by Jan. 1st

How do we get our animals?

- You must register online by September 15th.
- Everything is on PayNGo
 - Log in, select “high school”, “Jordan”, “Katy ISD Livestock Show”, and “Katy Livestock Show Entries”
- Horticulture & Floral Show Entries are also due by September 15th

ANIMAL PRICES

- You may purchase an entry for either the Floral, Ag Mech, or Horticulture Show in addition to your Livestock Project **or** you can do just the non-animal project shows
- Floral, Ag Mech, and Horticulture Projects are **NOT** eligible for the Live Auction, only the Grand and Reserve Champions will receive a premium award

Livestock Show Payments

All exhibitors must meet the following financial responsibilities:

- \$25 non-refundable entry fee due by 9/15/2024 for all show entries
- Steer: \$2,100 per animal submitted by 4/15/2024
- Lamb: \$500 per animal submitted by 9/15/2024
- Goat: \$600 per animal submitted by 9/15/2024
- Swine: \$400 per animal submitted by 9/15/2024
- Broiler: TBD per bird (25 minimum) per animal submitted by 9/15/2024

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- ❖ Broiler cost will be determined by supplier in the Fall
- Rabbit: \$325 per 5 rabbits submitted by 9/15/2024
- Horticulture: \$150 per project submitted by 9/15/2024
- Floral: \$125 per project submitted by 9/15/2024

FUNDRAISING

All Students who are going to participate on a CDE/LDE team or show are REQUIRED to sell at least \$500 of the two fundraisers.

\$100 of the total must be from Catalog Ads

FUNDRAISING

It cost \$\$\$ to be successful!!

If you DO NOT fundraise and are on a CDE team you must pay \$250 to compete.

Incentives:

\$500= FFA Jacket/ Optional Jordan FFA Windbreaker or other jacket

\$1000= Belt Buckle

*Students must attend all FFA meetings in order to show. UIL activities and absences from school for being sick are the only approved absences. If you have UIL activity you **MUST** make an ag teacher aware **AHEAD** of time. All absences are subject to ag teacher discretion under extenuating circumstances.

If you miss an FFA meeting for an unapproved absence, you must see an ag teacher within 24 hours of your return to school, those who do not come in time, are subject to additional requirements.
